Credit Transfer Arrangement on General Education Courses

For the priority arrangement in credit transfer in General Education, “1st” denotes the GE course for the first 3-credit-point transfer and “2nd” denotes the GE course for the second 3-credit-point transfer.

1. The Associate Degree / Higher Diploma graduates are exempted 3 - 6 credit points by the University in General Education upon their admission to the Five-year Full-time DD-BA(CAC)&BEEd(MU)/(VA) programmes.
2. All students must take the General Education (GE) Foundation Course (4 credit points), University ePortfolio Course (3 credit points), and Co-curricular and Service Learning Course (3 credit points). Normally no credit transfer is granted in these courses.
3. Credit transfer will be granted in one or two GE Breadth courses (GEBC) among Positive and Values Education (PAVE) Course and GE Interdisciplinary Course (GEIC), as DD-BA(CAC)&BEEd(MU)/(VA) students are not required to take any course from GE New Six Arts. The priority of the GEBCs for credit transfer are shown in the table above.
4. For the case of granting Block Credit Transfer for one 3-cp GEBC only, credit transfer will be made for PAVE Course. Students are needed to take the GEIC for completing all requirement in GEBCs.
