The appointee will be assigned to System Services Section of the University Library. He/she will be responsible for supporting and enhancing web based programs and applications, maintenance of self-served systems such as Self Pick-up Stations, as well as scripting and coding of other library systems. The appointment will initially be a period of two years.

Applicants should have an Associate Degree or a Higher Diploma in Information Science/Technology or related fields with at least two years of working experience in web application development. Applicants should be self-motivated, willing to learn appropriate technologies and able to work with Library staff of various levels. Work with a team of system professionals. Opportunity to gain experience in full-stack development as well as latest VR/gaming/meta applications. Fresh university graduates with good potential may also be considered.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
