The appointee will provide a full range of learning and teaching, knowledge-transfer, and administrative support to an e-learning and blended learning project focusing on field study and virtual field trips. The appointee is expected to assist in designing teaching and learning materials, collecting and compiling learning and teaching data, preparing workshops and class activities, writing reports, and performing other related duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of approximately 8 months.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with a Master's degree in Geography or related disciplines (such as Education, Urban Planning, Environmental Studies, Sustainable Studies, GIS). For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. They should have experience in qualitative/quantitative data analysis, education material production and computer literacy (i.e. MS Word, Excel, Chinese word processing, database creation and management). They should have a good command of English and Chinese and be able to work independently with good planning, organization and interpersonal skills.
