

Project Assistant (Ref: 2400724) Research and Development Office (Knowledge Transfer Sub-Office)

The appointee will be responsible for providing support to technology transfer and entrepreneurship activities in the Knowledge Transfer (KT) Sub-office. Main duties include (a) assisting in the execution of entrepreneurship schemes and related activities, including training workshops, mentorship programs, incubation and business support, ceremonies and networking opportunities, etc.; (b) assisting in organising business networking and marketing events; (c) Preparing relevant reports and marketing materials (including social media); and (d) performing any other job-related duties as assigned by Director of KT/Head of KT/supervisor.

The appointees need to work off-campus at times and be flexible in working hours. Duty trips outside Hong Kong will be occasionally required (including but not limited to the Greater Bay Area). The appointment will be for a period of two years, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with relevant post-qualification working experience in a tertiary education setting. They should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese and Putonghua), be attentive to details and be self-motivated. Applicants with experience in event organization and/or entrepreneurship schemes are preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
