- 1) Artificial Intelligence-based Examination of Mangrove Wetland Dynamics in the Deep Bay Area**
- 2) Microplastic Pollution and Its Vector Role for Pathogens and Antibiotic Resistance Gene**

[Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will participate in research projects related to the topics of (1) Mangrove Wetland Dynamics and (2) the related coastal pollution and its effects. The major duties include conducting literature review, collecting samples from the coastal environment and sample processing, data processing, developing protocols for big data analysis, preparing standard operating procedures, and performing data analysis. They will also be responsible for drafting reports, papers, and proposals for submission, carrying out general administrative duties; and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Relevant research experience in (1) wetland and (2) marine fish is preferred. Preference will be also given to applicants with good knowledge of marine related research and ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
