The appointee will provide a wide range of research support to a sizeable project on financial education in local primary schools, such as assisting general research work including but not limited to the literature review, data collection and analysis, liaising with stakeholders, conducting searches and reviews, and performing other research-related duties as assigned. The initial appointment will be for two years with the possibility of renewal, subject to mutual agreement.

The appointee should have at least level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preferably with a Bachelor's degree in a relevant field (e.g., finance, education, social sciences) and have relevant experience in program evaluation, preferably in financial education.

The priority will provide applicants with strong analytical skills, attention to details, excellent communication and report-writing abilities. The applicants may show their ability to work independently and as part of a team.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
