He/she is also expected to provide administrative support to the project team. There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publications in international and Chinese journals.

Applicants should possess a recognized Master's degree in education, information technologies in education, engineering, global studies in education or related disciplines, with a few years of postqualification full-time working experience, preferably gained in tertiary institutions. They should have excellent oral and written communication skills in English and Chinese, strong literacy in computer applications, as well as time and task management skills. Applicants should also be good team players, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and must be able to finish assigned tasks independently. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to sit for a written test.
