Project Title: Apply AI teaching and classroom management skill practice for pre-service teachers in Field Experience

[Appointment Period: 24 months]

The appointee will provide research support for the project "Apply AI speech and classroom management skill practice for pre-service teachers in Field Experience". Key responsibilities include conducting literature reviews on effective teaching and classroom management practices, assisting in the design and development of training programs and tools to help pre-service or in-service teachers develop and enhance these skills, and coordinating the implementation of the training program and live launch in the field experience. He/She will also be responsible for collecting and analyzing data on the pre-service teachers' experiences and the effectiveness of the training, preparing research reports and deliverables, and providing administrative and logistical support for the project.

Applicants should have a bachelor's degree in education, educational psychology, or related field, including knowledge of children development, teaching, and classroom management. With experience of AI technology projects particularly in the context of education or teacher training, would be considered an advantage. Demonstrated experience in conducting educational research, including data collection, analysis, and reporting, is essential. Proficiency in quantitative and qualitative research methods, with experience in using SPSS and NVivo, is required. Strong IT skills, including proficiency in the Microsoft Office suite. Strong analytical and problem-solving skills, excellent written and verbal communication skills in both English and Chinese, and the ability to work collaboratively in a team environment are also required. The appointment will be for a period of 24 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement and satisfactory performance.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
