The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably with a Master's Degree, in Psychology or a related discipline. They should have good command of both English and Chinese, and competency in data analysis and academic writing. They should be responsible, organized and attentive to details. Data analysis proficiency in Python or R is a must. Experiences in neuroscience and machine learning is highly preferred.
