The Department of Early Childhood Education is inviting applications for the position of Research Assistant I for the project "Risky Online Behaviors, Personal Traits and Subjective Well-being Among Hong Kong University Students: A Pilot Study Applying Ecological Momentary Assessment". This study will investigate the intricate dynamics between university students' prosocial and risky online behaviors, personal traits, and psychological well-being, employing an innovative mixed-methods approach.

The appointee will provide research and administrative support to the project. The appointee will be responsible for reviewing the literature, collecting data (including implementing surveys and Ecological Momentary Assessment), analysing data, and drafting reports and manuscripts. The appointee will also coordinate activities facilitating the dissemination of research findings, and perform other duties as assigned by project leaders. The appointment will be for a period of 6 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree in Psychology, Education, or other related disciplines. He/She should be highly responsible, intrinsically motivated, and able to work independently. Applicants should also have strong interpersonal communication and analytical skills, and high proficiency in both written and spoken Chinese and English. Applicants with a master's degree of relevant disciplines, proficiency in Cantonese, strong PC skills (MS Office), and knowledge of statistical software (e.g., SPSS, Mplus, R) will be preferable.
