Project Title: Empower Families to Enhance Children's Reading Skills through an Interactive Self-learning Storybook Reading Programme

[Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will be responsible for supporting research projects on storybook reading for 2-8 year-old children. Specific duties include preparing multimedia e-learning materials (e.g. videos, audio recordings, PPT, worksheets) for an online learning platform, liaising with schools and parents, preparing research materials, collecting data, analyzing data, and supervising student helpers. The appointee is also expected to provide administrative support to the Principal Investigator and the research team. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Early Childhood Education or a Postgraduate Diploma in Early Childhood Education (PGDECE) with relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Applicants should be competent in teaching children, video editing (e.g. VSDC Video Editor, Adobe Premiere), photo editing (e.g. Adobe Illustrator), working independently, and multitasking. They should have high proficiency in both English and Chinese and strong communication abilities. Relevant research experience would be an advantage. Immediate availability is preferred.
