The appointee will be responsible for providing research and administrative support to the project team. She/he will be involved in literature review, liaising with internal and external parties, developing learning and teaching package and other research materials, data collection, processing, drafting research papers, and providing technical support for the activities; and performing other administrative duties assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Bachelor's Degree or above in Chinese Language, Educational, Language Education, or a related discipline. Applicants should be familiar with both quantitative and qualitative research methods, and demonstrate good Chinese and English language proficiency. Cantonese proficiency and experience in developing school-based Chinese curriculum and lesson observation is highly preferable.
