

Educational Development Assistant (holding the functional title of Assistant Educational Development Officer) (Ref: 2401228) Centre for Learning, Teaching and Technology

The appointees will provide implementation support for several projects on the utilization of innovative technology in higher education as well as the promotion of artificial intelligence (AI) literacy and STEAM competency. Duties include assisting in developing, administering and analyzing institution-wide surveys and interviews, assisting in literature review on technology-related teaching and learning (e.g., generative artificial intelligence, metaverse, gamification), as well as coordinating and collaborating with internal and external team members to implement and validate project platforms and deliverables. The appointees will also assist in developing and reviewing resources and use cases, organizing workshops, courses, seminars and other activities for project dissemination. The appointees will conduct evaluation on project activities, prepare academic papers and reports, as well as performing other duties assigned by Director, Executive Co-Director and Associate Directors. The appointment will be for a period of 24 months.

Applicants should have a recognized Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Education, Psychology, Social Sciences, Artificial Intelligence, Computer Science, STEM and/or related disciplines. They should have good written and verbal communication skills in English and Chinese (including spoken Cantonese), high capability of developing educational materials, good computer literacy, good analytical and problem-solving skills, as well as being attentive to details. They should be self-motivated to work independently, while possessing good interpersonal skills to work as a team member. Knowledge of AI, STEAM, metaverse, computer programming and using statistical packages such as SPSS and R will be advantageous. Immediately available is preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
