Project Title: Chinese Language Assessment of Primary Progressive Aphasia - Cantonese (CLAP-C)

[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will be mainly responsible for specific tasks including assisting in CLAP-C assessment, scheduling language test sessions and MRI imaging sessions for participants, managing the participant recruitment matrices, and organizing and cleaning research data. He/She is also expected to perform administrative support to the research team, including handling IRB application, modification, and updates, converting MRI images from DICOM to NlfTI data format, and submitting invoices and budgets of the project to the joint project university, the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). He/She will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Project Supervisor. The appointment will be for 6 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants preferred to obtain a Bachelor's Degree with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience in research/research support. He/She should have strong interpersonal and coordination skills and a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese. Cantonese proficiency is mandatory, and we also prefer those who can speak Mandarin. Applicants should be enthusiastic, attention to details, and be self-motivated.
