Project Title: Investigating Adolescents' Digital Citizenship through Social Media: (Trans)Formation, Digital Literacy Practices and Influential Factors

## [Appointment Period: around 7 months]

We are seeking a high caliber candidate to help us extract insights from the large-scale social media texts to understand the youths' language usage in the digital age. The appointee will provide support to the research team, and perform academic duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. Research or work experience in natural language processing (NLP)-related projects is highly desirable. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 7 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's degree in computer science, NLP, computational linguistics or a related discipline, plus one year's post-Master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate in the abovementioned disciplines, with solid knowledge of NLP techniques. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree (preferably Master's degree) in related disciplines with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience. They should also have good communication and organizational skills, high level of proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese, good ability to work both independently and collaboratively. Immediate availability is preferred.
