Principal Lecturer / Senior Lecturer I (Ref: 2401330) Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation Education / Academy for Applied Policy Studies and Education Futures

The appointee will play a pivotal role in providing effective leadership in programme and curriculum development, quality assurance and continuous improvement of learning and teaching within our University in the areas of entrepreneurship, public policy and public management. Specifically, s/he will contribute to the teaching, implementation and management of courses and programmes at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. S/he is expected to lead initiatives in curriculum development, ensuring alignment with the latest educational methodologies and quality standards; spearhead the creation and enhancement of teaching and learning materials and methodologies; engage actively in the development and implementation of innovative projects; coordinate and supervise student projects/practicums/ activities and oversee development projects as well as participate in centre/academy activities, meetings, various boards, and committees, as well as contribute to the university through community service and leadership.

Applicants for the post of Principal Lecturer should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 15 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 6 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience. Possession of a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g., PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence will be an asset. Applicants possessing relevant teaching and professional/practical experience in the fields of entrepreneurship and public/educational policy at tertiary education setting are highly preferred.

For the post of Senior Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience / professional experience.
