The appointee will take on a vital role in supporting a two-phase sequential mixed-method research project that explores what constitutes a genuinely international academic and aims to inform decision-making at the institutional level regarding the appointment and promotion of academic staff. Key responsibilities will include conducting literature reviews, collecting and analysing data, writing research reports and dissemination documents, overseeing administrative tasks, and fulfilling other duties as directed by the project leaders.

Applicants should have a Master's degree in Education, Educational Leadership and Management, Sociology, Geography, Politics, or related fields, and at least one-year post-qualification working experience or a doctorate. Exceptional communication and academic writing skills are highly desirable.
