The Department of English Language Education is inviting applications for the position of Research Assistant I for the project titled "Participatory design of game-based formative assessment to support cross-curricular reading and early identification of struggling readers". This project aims to work with local frontline teachers and industry programmers to design games that support students' cross-curricular reading and help teachers to identify struggling readers.

The appointee supports a variety of research and administrative tasks. The duties include reviewing literature, designing games, coordinating with internal and external research collaborators, development of research instruments, data collection and analysis, and performing any other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably Master's degree in Education, Educational Technology, Computer Science, Psychology, and other related fields.
