Applicants should have at least a Master's degree, preferably in Educational Leadership, Artificial Intelligence, or related disciplines. He/she should be familiar with at least one research software (e.g., Nvivo, Mplus), demonstrate high proficiency in written and spoken English and Cantonese, have excellent communication and interpersonal skills, and be able to work independently and collaboratively in a team environment. Related research experience in managing large-scale datasets, conducting meta-analyses or utilizing Artificial Intelligence is advantageous.
