The appointee will assist the Principal Investigator with his/her research project, such as conducting literature reviews, preparing and analysing data, drafting summaries of initial findings, preparing for conference presentations and publications, and supporting the write-up reports. He/She will also help with administrative duties, such as assisting in teaching-related tasks, overseeing student helpers, planning and coordinating academic activities, and any other duties as assigned. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 23 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement and funding. Immediate availability will be an advantage.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree in modern Chinese literature or a related major and several years of working experience. They should be highly proficient in both English and Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua), attentive to fine details, self-motivated, able to work under tight timeline, and have good communication skills. Preference will be given to those with experience in large-scale research projects on Chinese literature. Those who are familiar with Hong Kong literature would have an added advantage.
