If you are passionate about school education and want to thrive in a high-impact research environment related to student-centered discipline-integrated approaches (i.e., STEAM education and Transdisciplinary Education), you may consider this chance for you.

The appointee will be responsible for reviewing the literature, conducting inter-/transdisciplinary tasks with project participants, collecting data, coding and analyzing data, and drafting reports and manuscripts. The appointee will also coordinate activities facilitating the dissemination of research findings and perform any other duties assigned by the project leader. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 9 months.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants with a Bachelor's degree in music education or an education-related discipline, with a strong interest in arts-integrated education is preferable. He/she should have research-related writing experience in both Chinese and English; should be highly responsible, intrinsically motivated, and able to work independently; and should also possess good interpersonal and organizational skills. Preference will be given to the one with an international educational-related perspective, a growth mindset, and is flexible and able to work under pressure.
