The appointee will be responsible for providing research support for a project focused on English language learning. Key responsibilities include creating, enhancing, and refining educational games aimed at facilitating English language learning, as well as performing other tasks as assigned. Additionally, the appointee will undertake any other duties assigned by their supervisor. The appointment will last approximately 9 months, with the possibility of renewal based on mutual agreement.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should hold a Bachelor's Degree. Applicants with Master's degrees are preferable. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants with Bachelor's Degree are preferable. Preference will be given to candidates with good skills in Unity or other game development tools.
