We are seeking a highly motivated individual for the position of a half-time project officer for the International One Belt One Road (OBOR) Arts and Culture Conference in September 2025. The successful candidate will be responsible for contacting local (Hong Kong), mainland, and international scholars, musicians, and artists for participating in the conference. Key responsibilities of the candidate include providing comprehensive administrative support, such as transportation, accommodation, venue arrangements, and catering for the events. Additionally, the candidate will assist in publicity efforts, which involve designing promotional materials and managing social media campaigns. Other duties will include handling routine administrative tasks related to the program and performing additional tasks as assigned by the supervisor. The candidate will also help prepare evaluation reports to ensure the conference meets its objectives and achieves success.

Applicants should have a recognized degree with several years of post-qualification working experience and demonstrate proficiency in both written and spoken Chinese (Cantonese and Mandarin) and English. Strong interpersonal and communication skills are essential. Additionally, candidates should have a high level of literacy in computer applications, particularly advanced knowledge of MS Word and Excel. The ability to thrive under pressure in a fast-paced environment is crucial, as is being self-motivated and capable of working independently while also being an effective team member. Experience in organizing conferences or academic events will be considered an advantage.
