

Senior Lecturer II (Ref: 2500368) Department of Special Education and Counselling Faculty of Education and Human Development

The Department is now seeking qualified and highly dedicated persons for teaching positions at the rank of Senior Lecturer II. Successful applicants will undertake teaching responsibilities across undergraduate and postgraduate programmes while contributing to curriculum development and departmental initiatives. This three-year appointment includes serving as Field Experience (FE) Coordinators for designated programmes, requiring close collaboration with educational partners to enhance teacher training outcomes.

The appointee will deliver instruction in Field Experience courses and teach core/elective courses focused on special needs education and diverse learning requirements and support for new programme development and curriculum innovation. Key responsibilities include conducting instructional briefings, coordinating student projects, and driving professional development initiatives in inclusive education. As FE Coordinator, the role involves overseeing block practice placements, ensuring adherence to pedagogical standards, and bridging educational theory with classroom practice to improve practicum quality. Candidates must demonstrate at least three years of hands-on teaching experience in Hong Kong schools, with proven ability to collaborate effectively across programme teams and departmental committees.

Qualifications require a professional teaching certification such as PGDE or Education Bureau-recognized Qualified Teacher Status (QTS). Applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience in relevant areas; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience in the relevant subject discipline.
