Master of Arts in Child and Family Education Entrance Scholarship 2024/25

1. Background

Master of Arts in Child and Family Education Entrance Scholarship was first offered in 2018/19 to Year 1 students of the Master of Arts in Child and Family Education [MA(CFE)] programme, aiming at recognising students' academic excellence, outstanding international exposure and contributions to the community in the field of child and family education.

2. Provision of the Scholarship

- (a) It is proposed that a total of two scholarships of HK\$30,000 will be offered to two Year 1 students each year.
- (b) Students will receive the scholarship only once in their studies of the programme.
- (c) The continuation of the scholarships will be reviewed every year.
- (d) The scholarships will offset part of the awardees' tuition fees.
- (e) Scholarships will be disbursed in two installments: HK\$15,000 in the first semester and HK\$15,000 in the second semester.
- (f) The scholarship recipients are allowed to hold concurrent scholarships or awards but the total amount should not exceed annual tuition. Nevertheless, scholarship/ award to support outbound activities will not be counted towards the aforesaid ceiling of scholarship amount.

3. Eligibility Criteria

- (a) Enrolled as a local or non-local student of Master of Arts in Child and Family Education in 2024/25

4. Selection Criteria

- (a) Records of academic achievements:
 - with a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 3.30 on a 4.00 scale or equivalent in their respective degrees not lower than undergraduate level;
 - academic awards/scholarships/grants;
 - publications
- (b) Track records in:
 - i. International exposure and knowledge in global issues; and/or
 - ii. contributions to the community in the field of child and family education/services

5. Nomination and Selection Procedure

- (a) Programme Leader and at least one teaching team member of MA(CFE) will serve as the selection panel.
- (b) Recommendations made by the selection panel will be approved by the Head of Department of Early Childhood Education.
- (c) Interested students should apply for the scholarship with
 - i) a curriculum vitae and/or documentary evidence of his/her records of academic achievement, and

- ii) a statement of application (no more than 400 words) outlining his/her academic achievement, international exposure/knowledge in global issues, and contributions to child and family education/services in the local community.
- (d) Application deadline: In July each year
- (e) Internal interview: In August each year
- (f) Announcement of results: By end of August each year
- (g) The list of recipients will be sent to the Committee on Scholarships and Prizes for noting.

6. Conditions of Award

- (a) The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient is unsatisfactory or ceases to be a student of the EdUHK. The Department reserves the right to ask the recipient to refund the scholarship either in part or in full.
- (b) The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient has committed any unethical and/or undesirable behavior and/or violated the regulations laid down by the University. The Department reserves the right to make judgement on undesirable behavior.
- (c) If no candidate meets the eligibility and selection criteria in the academic year, the scholarship will not be offered.
- (d) Recipient of the scholarship is required to attend functions related to scholarships organised by the Department.
- (e) The EdUHK reserves the right to deduct the scholarship from the student's outstanding University fees (if any).

7. Handling of Information and Personal Data

The information collected from you will be used for considering, processing and administering your application for "Master of Arts in Child and Family Education Entrance Scholarship". It is voluntary for you to provide your personal information to the Selection Panel. If you fail to produce any of the information required, your application may not be processed. The collected data will be purged after 2 years. Your personal data captured might be transferred or shared with the Faculty of Education and Human Development "other unit(s)" of the EdUHK but will not be transferred to outside parties.
