



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

- Free of charge
- Local & non-local students are all eligible
- Multiple Choices (MC) in test format
- Test results are valid forever
- Future re-take of individual test with unsatisfied result
- If you miss application deadline at 5 pm on 9 Aug 2024, you may need to wait for BLNST & CRE in June 2025

The coming CRE and BLNST NEW!

The coming CRE and BLNST is tentatively scheduled to be held in Hong Kong on 5 October 2024, or another date within October 2024 if necessary. For the convenience of those studying or residing outside Hong Kong, the above examination is also tentatively scheduled to be held on 7 December seven other cities, namely Beijing, Shanghai, London, New York, Vancouver and Sydney.

Who may apply

Applicants for the coming CRE and BLNST should be -

(a) holders of degree (not including Associate Degree); or

(b) individuals who will have attained a degree (**not** including Associate Degree) in the academic year of 2024-25 or 2025-26; or

(c) noiders of a qualification meeting the entry requirement on professional qualifications for civil service degree or professional posts.

Applicants should read the "Notes for Applicants " and "Frequer ed Questions " carefully before making an application. Application the coming CRE and BLNST must be submitted before 5:00 p.m. on 9 August 2024




