Dr Jill Brown is a Senior Lecturer in the Faculty of Education at Monash University in Australia. Jill teaches in a range of language-related areas, supervises research at Honors, Masters and Doctoral levels, and is responsible for several international programs in TESOL. Areas of research include language study abroad, language and literacy in the secondary school context, educational provision for refugee ESL students and other minority groups, and, her main area of interest, teaching and learning English. Jill is on her second visit to HKIED and is working with the English Department on research into the impact of language study abroad programs on language skills, intercultural competencies and pedagogical understandings.

Case Study and Professional Narratives

This workshop will consider the different approaches to case study and the ways in which these add to our understandings of teacher work. Participants will work with the presenter's professional narrative and explore the ways in which this narrative can be variously interpreted by the researcher and by the narrator. They will then share in the construction of their own professional narratives and critique the ways in which these are understood and constructed by others.
