Reasonable Academic Accommodations

Possible academic accommodations will be developed jointly with the needy student and the support staff on a case-by-case basis, appropriate to the nature and extent of the student's disability.

Examples of Key Strategies for Supporting Students with Special Needs:

- Provide lecture notes and/or PowerPoint slides in advance, in hard and/or soft copy
- Provide enlarged printed materials
- Allow for audio-visual aids, e.g. audio-taping, headphone, telescope
- Arrange preferential seating
- Allow extra time and/or separate room for examination
- Consider different formats for assessment, e.g. oral instead of writing and vice versa
