I. Aims

Throughout this training, students would be equipped with knowledge and skills of mental health first aid, thereby raising their awareness towards mental health, assisting them to care for people around them, and providing initial support to peers who are developing mental illness or are in a mental health crisis.

II. Mental Health First Aid Course (Standard)

"Mental Health First Aid" course was initiated by experienced mental health research and education experts in Australia and was introduced to Hong Kong in 2004. It aims to enhance public awareness of mental health and help trained persons identify their mental status and that of others, and hence, initiate necessary intervention and support on time and encourage those in need to receive professional help.

Course Content:

- a. To develop a basic understanding of common mental health illnesses, including Depression, Anxiety, Disorder, Substance Abuse and Psychosis, etc;
- b. To identify symptoms of mental problem or mental health crisis;
- c. To provide initial and appropriate support to prevent further worsening of problems;
- d. To assist persons in need to seek professional treatment, services and make use of appropriate community resources.

Participants who **participated 100% would receive a certificate**, which is acknowledged by Mental Health First Aid International. Please be reminded to attend on time.
