### II. Allocation Mechanism

#### (a) Hall Vouchers for FT UGC-F UG students

- All first-year full-time students on a UGC-funded undergraduate programme: Guaranteed hall residency for two semesters (i.e. 2 virtual hall vouchers: one voucher for one semester residence, and two vouchers for a wholeyear residence)
- One of which should be taken up during the first year of study, otherwise, one of the vouchers will be forfeited.

2c.	Returning UGC-funded FT UG students (with no voucher / opted not to use voucher)	Hall Point → Computer-generated randomized number, if same hall point

Allocation priority for eligible student groups	Allocation priority for individual applicants in each group
3. UGC-funded FT PGDE local students	Hall Point → Computer-generated randomized number, if same hall point
4. UGC-funded FT HD(ECE) students	Hall Point → Computer-generated randomized number, if same hall point
5. Self-funded FT UG students	Hall Point → Computer-generated randomized number, if same hall point

#### (a) Read Application Guidelines Carefully

- Please read carefully the <u>Application Guidelines</u> on the Hall Management Section's website before application.
- Online application <u>MUST BE</u> via iHostel System within application period.
- Applicants can modify/cancel the application record before the application deadline. Only the final submission will be processed.
- Late application and modification of information / document submitted
  AFTER the application period will NOT be processed.

#### (b) Make Every Decision Carefully

#### Prioritize your hall choices wisely:

- Residency (Whole-year / Sem 1 / Sem 2) → Hall Preference / Room Type
- Join our hall visit to understand more about our student halls.

#### Think twice before you clicked:

- Once you have clicked the 'Accept Conditional Offer' button on the iHostel system, the 1st installment of hall fee will be charged automatically on your e-Billing account.
- The charge on the e-Billing account <u>will NOT be exempted</u> even you finally decline the offer or fail to settle the payment by the designated deadline.
