COVID-related Requirements

1. Only fully vaccinated (i.e. 3 doses for uninfected person/ 2 doses for recovered person with official proof) students are eligible to participate; other vaccination status will not be considered.
2. Any COVID-related costs, including but not limited to quarantine hotel costs, are not considered as any part of the programme fee, and are therefore not supported by GLEF.
3. You are solely responsible for your quarantine hotel arrangement (wherever applicable).
4. You have the responsibility to keep yourself up-to-date with the COVID-19 and quarantine requirements in the destination and Hong Kong (wherever applicable).
