1. You are required to fulfill 100% attendance of all sessions, coming in late and leaving early will be considered as absent. You will be assumed to have withdrawn from the activity should you fail to fulfil the attendance requirement.
2. You are required to settle the programme fee and submit all required documents on time.
3. Withdrawing from the activity at any point in time or failing to depart, any of the payment made will NOT be refunded.
4. You are responsible for keeping yourself up-to-date with the immigration policy and requirements in the destination and Hong Kong (wherever applicable).
5. You are responsible for checking their own validity of travelling documents and VISA, and your own GLEF balance before application.
6. You are required to submit and complete the application of the Global Learning Enhancement Fund (GLEF) for the activity, and observe the [GLEF User Guide for Students](#).
7. Deposit will be refunded, upon your successful completion of the activity, within two months after the activity end date.

SAO may exercise their right to terminate the activity in the event of emergency, including but not limited to political instability, social problem, natural disaster, environmental hygiene, widespread of an epidemic, the World Health Organization or The Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government issuing a travel warning of the destination before departure or during the tour, or international travel becoming restrictive.
