Dr Tan Weigiang on the impact of the U.S. presidential election on China-U.S. relations

- *TVB* interviewed Dr Tan Weiqiang, Associate Professor in the Department of Social Sciences and Policy Studies. He believed the outcome of the U.S. presidential election will have little impact on the China-U.S. relations. He also noted that both Kamala Harris and Donald Trump seem to have a consistent approach toward China, indicating ongoing friction regardless of the election outcome. He emphasised the need to consider future policies and responses that will affect China and Hong Kong after the election.
