The ability to differentiate the use of present and past tense in a contextualized passage.


## 2. Critical features

- ii. To use the correct tense to describe past event and usual habit with or without the presence of time adverbials.




Measuring targets (e.g. prior knowledge, understanding of the critical aspects, knowledge transfer)






From the result, we found that P.5 students were better than P.4 students in recognizing the time adverbial.







Both levels were doing fine in present tense, but they had problems with past tense.





## Samples of Pre-test

## Habitual Action

The purpose of doing section D is to test students' usage of the present and past tense.

## 4. Students' performance in Pre-test/interview

- 1.Students learnt the time adverbial (always, usually, often, sometimes) as a function of frequency, but they did not realize those words could also share a function as a present tense.
- 2. Most of the students failed to use the previous cues when the time adverbial is clearly present in that particular sentence.
- 3. In section D, most students were only able to write on the habitual events.





## 7. Teachers' Reflections

#### Ms Poon's Thoughts

- Students are able to use English to answer the teacher's questions.
- Teaching the definitions are important.
- According to the students, weakness to plan a lesson is much more effective.

#### Ms Wong's Thoughts

- Students have difficulties to absorb the knowledge of usage of present and past tense at the same time.
- It's hard to solve the problems among different English levels of the students in such a short time.

#### Mr. Lai's Thoughts

- An intensive study to understand the basic problem of students is necessary.
- The Learning Study approach can help to analyse the basic problem by breaking the teaching process into very small parts.
- Class with a wide learning diversity may find difficulties to proceed.
